Corporate volunteers are integral to the **Into**University programme, providing crucial support and positive role models for our students, as well as invaluable experiences and opportunities.

A variety of engagement opportunities are available for employees, which can fit around different work schedules and can take place at a number of convenient locations, including online.

Academic Support

After-school sessions held in our local centres to assist students with their learning. Volunteers support students' (aged 7-18) academic progress and provide inspiration and encouragement. Volunteers receive training and will need to commit to one session per week over the academic year.



The FOCUS Programme

Business in FOCUS

A high impact, one-day business simulation, run by **Into**University staff, where volunteers support a group of students (aged 13-18) to develop key skills such as teamwork, communication and leadership.

Careers in FOCUS

A series of volunteer-led, interactive workshops to introduce a group of students (aged 11-16) to different career options and deepen their understanding of the working world.

Corporate Mentoring

A one-to-one mentoring programme supporting a student in their final year of school with the transition to Higher Education.

Staff Mentoring

A one-to-one mentoring scheme for volunteers to support a member of the **Into**University management team. Staff Mentors provide advice and guidance, enabling our staff to grow and develop professionally within the charity.



IU Connect e-mentoring

A flexible online mentoring programme supporting **Into**University alumni (aged 18+), who are at university or another chosen pathway, via our platform – IU Connect. IU Connect mentors provide tailored guidance to students in areas such as networking, CV support, interview preparation and job application guidance.



Student Enrichment

Insight Days

A volunteer-led workshop inspiring our students to think about their futures and introducing a group of young people (aged 15+) to your sector and firm. Activities can include speed networking, mock interviews or an interactive activity mimicking the volunteers' role.

Academy of Enterprise

An opportunity to support our students (aged 17+) in this week-long programme as they develop their own products to sell at a real market, by running a masterclass on crucial business skills or providing guidance to one of the student teams.



Big City Bright Future

A three-week paid internship at your offices for a group of at least five students in their final year of school, for which **Into**University conduct all application and selection processes. Ahead of the internship, volunteers can support students with preparing their applications, practicing for interviews and represent their firm at a student insight day. During the internship, volunteers can support students with tasks, be their buddy, or run sessions on the firm.
