Secondary FOCUS Workshops

What is it about?

These workshops provide a cohort of 30 students in each year group with a minimum of 2 workshops a year relevant to the different stages of their school journey. Each workshop develops skills and knowledge which support students to fulfil their educational and career ambitions.

Which students?

We ask school partners to pick students who meet our criteria. Rather than selecting students already performing above the average for their year group, we ask that you identify students who are at risk of falling behind or not reaching their potential and/or students for whom an additional intervention may make a difference to their success.

When does it take place?

Workshops are normally 2 hours and take place during the school day. The scheduling of workshops will be arranged between you and your local **Into**University centre.

Who delivers the workshops?

The planning and delivery of all workshops is completed entirely by our trained and experienced **Into**University team. We aim to have a high staff to student ratio to ensure that the learning environment is positive and productive. Students also receive an **Into**University portfolio so that they can record their targets, progress and achievements.

S1	Workshop 1 Maximising Memory: Revision & Learning Techniques	Exploring a number of engaging learning and revision techniques to improve student confidence with lesson content.
	Workshop 2 Transferable Skills and Careers	Connecting learning and skills with future career possibilities.
S2	Workshop 3 Pathways to Success: Choosing Your Options	Understanding how your NQ options impact on educational and career pathways.
	Workshop 4 Introduction to University Life	Myth busting and exploring topics such as university courses, where to study and student finance.
S3	Workshop 5 Entrepreneurship	Exploring what makes entrepreneurs successful and how to apply these characteristics to our own lives.

Any Year Group	Day of University Life	A full day trip to a university. Experience the university environment: meet real students, tour the campus and complete a range of informative and inspiring activities.
Senior	School to	select a minimum of two workshops per year for each year group
Phase (S5/6)	Independent Learning	Identify and practise different independent learning techniques crucial for university and explore how these can be applied to S5/6 and college studies.
	Writing Personal Statements /UCAS	Reflect upon skills, experience and aspirations, and how these relate to university courses and can be communicated in writing.
	Alternative Pathways	Students will learn about alternative pathways to university that do not fall under traditional routes and have the opportunity to research different routes that might be suited to them.
	One-to-One Personal Statement Support	Students will have one-to-one appointments with Into University staff to help develop their personal statement.
	Skills for the Future	Prepare for the social and academic transition to university/other chosen aspiration by looking at independent living skills, networking, university learning styles and building learning power.
	Student Finance & Budgeting	Students are introduced to Student Finance, covering the support that is available to them, the application process and additional support such as grants and bursaries.
	Revision & Exam Technique	Students will have the opportunity to practise different revision techniques and reflect on where they can make changes to their lifestyle to maximise their potential.
	Employability	This workshop will prepare students for future work experience and employment. It will focus on CV writing, interview techniques and communication and etiquette in the workplace.

S1

What is it about?

A two-part programme enhancing students' understanding of university life. On day one pupils enjoy a 3 hour subject-based workshop which develops their knowledge of a degree subject. Examples include Medicine and Engineering. On day two young people spend the day at one of our partner universities and are supported in a workshop and on a campus tour by university student 'buddy' volunteers. Visiting a university, meeting undergraduates and participating in degree-based workshops inspires the students and helps them to view university as a tangible future goal.

Leadership in FOCUS

S2-S4

What is it about?

A three-day programme teaching leadership skills and raising aspirations, self-esteem and motivation. Students participate in a variety of team challenges and individual self-reflections that also develop teamwork, communication and negotiation skills. At the end of the programme, students set themselves challenging but achievable life goals.

When does it take place?


Business in FOCUS takes place at a corporate office.

Academic Support

S1-S6

What is it about?

Weekly sessions of focused academic study after school. Students are supported with their homework, coursework and examination revision or work on structured academic enhancing activities such as Independent Learning Projects.
